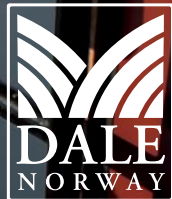

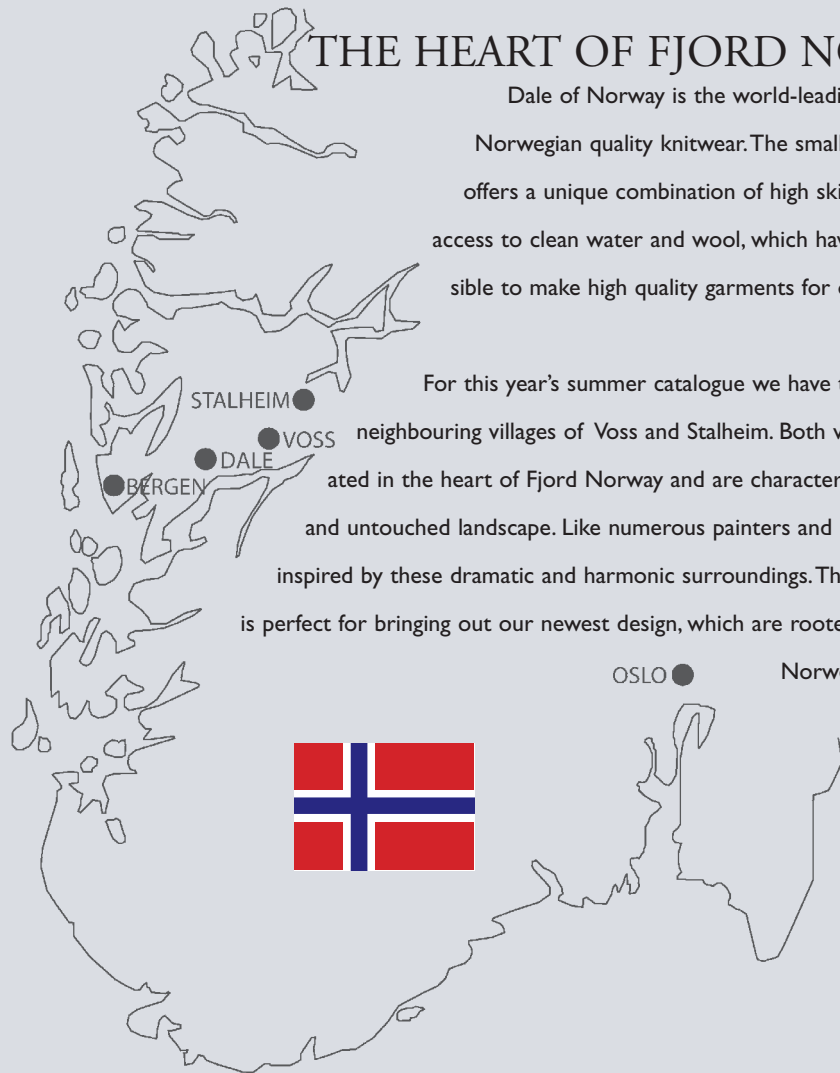


THE HEART OF FJORD NORWAY

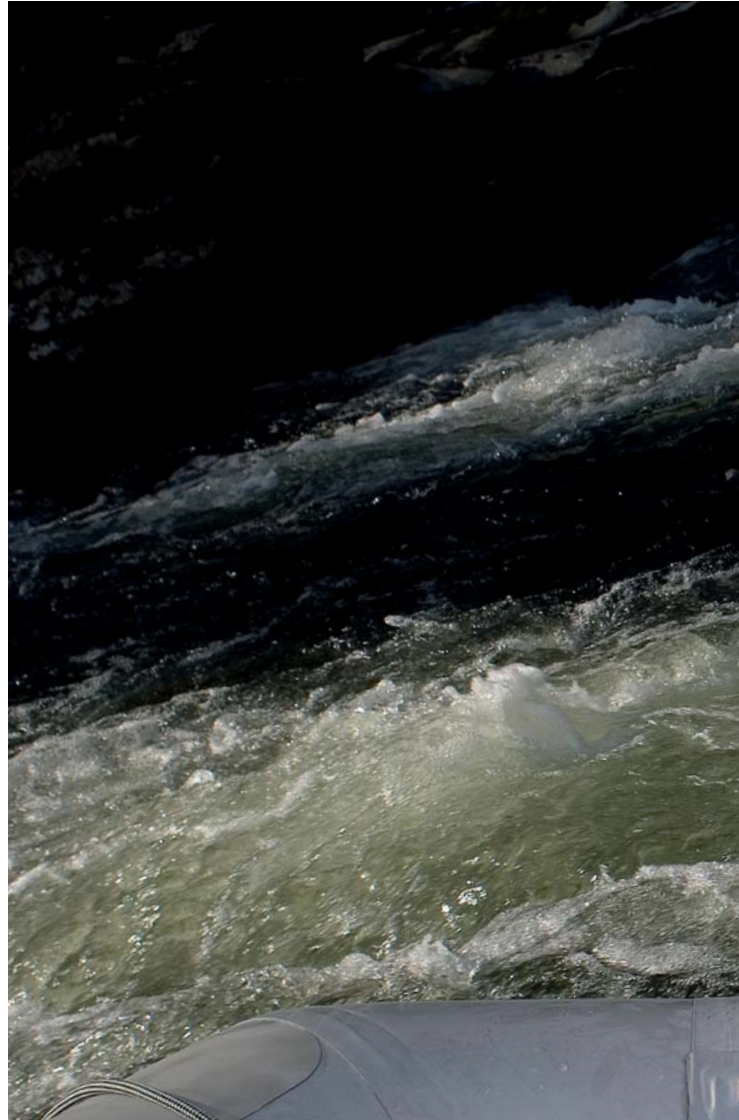


















STALHEIM HOTEL

Stalheim Hotel, family-run for more than a century, boasts a spectacular location that has thrilled generations of travellers. The ride up to the hotel on Stalheimskleiva, a narrow road with startling hairpin turns, starts the heart beating. But it is the incomparable panoramic view from the hotel terrace – overlooking the Nærøy Valley (which, along with the Nærøfjord, is on the UNESCO World Heritage Site list) – that truly takes your breath away. No wonder travellers agree that Stalheim Hotel is a “must-see.”

The hotel has 124 comfortable guest rooms and two restaurants. Its unique panorama lounge, accented with fine antiques, is a perfect place for the weary traveller to relax and contemplate the impressions of the day. Also at the Stalheim Hotel is the fascinating Stalheim Folk Museum, which provides an overview of the development of rural Norway since the late middle Ages along with a historical glimpse of everyday life on the farm and in the manor house.
